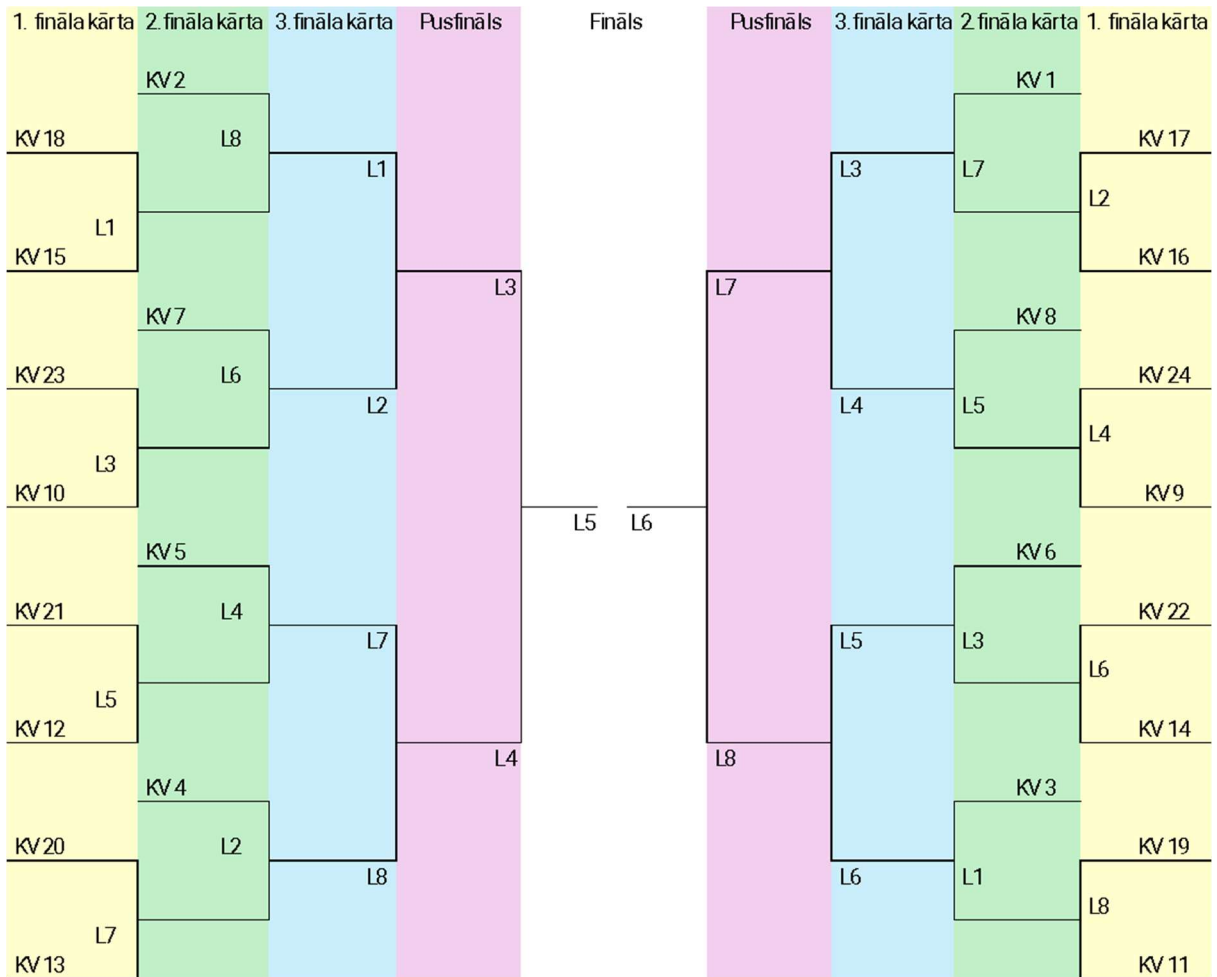

Tournament format

Qualification - Each participant plays 6 games. Based on the sum of the 6 games, Top20 athletes qualify for the next round (finals) after qualification results.

- 21. place – best junior who will not qualify for the Top20
 - 22. place – best woman who will not qualify for the Top20
 - 23. place – best senior who will not qualify for the Top20
 - 24. place – desperado winner
- The Top 24 players will qualify for the finals.

Finals bracket



1st Final Round (10:00-11:00) – 16 players, 9th-24th place. Mutual matches according to final group division, sum of two games (who has higher sum in two games wins). Winners advance to the next round. Losers will be ranked 17th-24th place according to qualification results.

2nd Final Round (11:00-12:00) – 8 players who won their matches in the 1st Final Round + 8 players who finished 1st-8th in qualifying. Mutual matches according to the final group division, sum of two games (who has higher sum in two games wins). Winners advance to the next round. Losers will be ranked 09th-16th place according to qualification results.

3rd Final Round (12:30-14:00) – 8 players who won their matches in the 2nd Final Round. Mutual matches according to the final group division, best of three games (match goes to two wins). Matches are played on a cross-line system. The winners advance to the next round - semi-finals. Losers will be ranked 05th-08th place according to qualification results.

Semifinals (14:30-16:00) – 4 winners who won their matches in the 3rd Final Round. Mutual matches according to the final group division, best of three games (match goes to two wins). Winners advance to the final. Matches are played on a cross-line system. Losers will be ranked 03th-04th place according to qualification results.

Final (16:00-17:30) – The winners of the semi-finals play each other in a best of three games (match goes to two wins). Matches are played on a cross-line system.

Additional information

- Lanes are prepared before each qualification squad, before 1st Final Round and the Semifinals.
- In qualification round max. 2 players on each lane.
- In qualification round, the lanes will change after each game - 1 lane to the right.
- In the event of a tie in the qualifying round, the player with the higher last game has the higher position.
- In the event of a tie in the Semifinals or Final, a roll-off is played.
- The cross-line system is not used during qualifying, 1st Final Round and 2nd Final Round.
- For the 3rd Final Round, Semifinals and Final a cross-line system will be used.
